Meghan was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia at 26 weeks pregnant with her 3rd baby in April of 2018. Meghan and her Husband Matthew were told they could only save her or the baby and they had to choose. Of course, that was not an option as they told the Doctors to just do what they could do to save both of them. Meghan stayed in the hospital for the next month under special care. At 30 weeks pregnant they could no longer delay and had no other option but to deliver the baby so they could immediately start treatment on Meghan before it was too late. There were so many risks for both



Mommy and Baby. After a very stressful couple of hours, little Raelyn Elise Ramirez was born in May at 2 pounds 4 ounces. Mommy and Baby were both doing fine! Meghan went into remission in January of 2019. Just weeks later she would have a second and then onto a third relapse in December of 2019 this time in the blast phase. After spending over a month in the hospital having chemo treatments and being monitored, she was able to come home in February of 2020. She is currently in remission but will need another bone marrow transplant to help keep her cancer free.



Kathy's Recipes

Giant Soft Pretzels

ingredients

- 1 cup water, plus
- 2 tablespoons water (at 70 to 80 degrees)
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- з tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 1/2 teaspoons active dry yeast
- 2 quarts water
- 1/2 cup baking soda
- 1 tablespoon kosher salt



Directions

Preheat oven to 425.

Place water, flour, sugar & yeast in a large bowl.

Mix and knead dough for 5 to 10 minutes.

(Add 2 TBS of flour after a few minutes if needed).

Turn dough onto a lightly floured surface.

Dívide into 8 balls.

Roll each ball out into 20-inch ropes and form into pretzel shape.

In a large sauce pan, bring water and baking soda to a boil.

Drop pretzels into water 2 at a time, boil for 10-15 seconds.

Remove with slotted spoons and drain on paper towels.

Place pretzles on a greased baking sheet and bake at 425 for 8-10 minutes or

until golden brown.

Spritz or lightly brush with water.

Sprinkle with salt and Enjoy!
